

NEW UF STUDENT EXCHANGES IN PERU AND COSTA RICA



- Where:** Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú (PUCP) in Lima
- When:** March-July 2009 (spring semester) or August-December 2009 (fall semester)
- Who:** UF undergraduate or graduate students with 2.5 GPA and 5 semesters of Spanish or the equivalent. Undergraduates must have completed one year of study at UF.
- Why:** Improve your Spanish proficiency, experience Latin American culture, take classes with Peruvian students, visit the Andean highlands, Incan ruins, and the Amazon rainforest.



- Where:** Universidad de Costa Rica (UCR) in San José
- When:** March-July 2009 (spring semester) or August-December 2009 (fall semester)
- Who:** UF undergraduate or graduate students with 3.0 GPA and 5 semesters of Spanish or the equivalent. Undergraduates must have completed one year of study at UF.
- Why:** Improve your Spanish proficiency, experience Latin American culture, take classes with Costa Rican students, visit tropical rainforests, beaches, and volcanoes.

Cost: UF tuition & fees; plus airfare, lodging, meals, health insurance and personal expenses. UF financial aid applies.
