○	<p>Caboclo da Lança (Figurine)</p> <p>-Small figurine of the Traditional Figure of Pernambuco. The Caboclo de lança figure is connected to the Maracatu dance representing an African warrior</p>	Brazil
○	<p>Berimbau with Drums (Figurine)</p> <p>-Small wooden representation of the important instrument used to accompany the Brazilian Sport of Capoeira</p>	Brazil
○	<p>Baiana Figurine with Bonfim Dress</p> <p>This small plastic and clothe figurine of an afrobrasilian woman in colorful garb is representative of the traditional "Baiana," working class women in the northeast state of Bahia who since colonial times have adorned similar clothing while working and vending in the historic district of Pelourinho. The dress is made out of "Fitas do senhor do Bonfim da Bahia" or Brazilian wish bracelets from the Bahia region.</p>	Brazil
