Unit Title: Childhood

Grade Level: 8th-12th

Length of the lesson: 100 minutes

Essential Questions:

Anticipatory set:

1. Students evaluate toys, books, music and videos from Spanish speaking countries. (Childhood items).

Activities:

- 1. All students get ready with their peer evaluation rubrics.
- 2. Presentations.
- 3. Class discussion.
