Unit Title: Trajes tradicionales

Grade Level: 8th-12th

Length of the lesson: 100 minutes

Objective: Students will learn about different traditional attires and will be able to do research about different traditional attires in different Spanish speaking countries.

Goals:

- 3. Students will learn about carnivals in Latin America and the traditional attires that are used during the carnivals.

Essential Questions:

- 1. What is a traditional dress?
- 2. What are the elements that compose a traditional attire?

Anticipatory set:

1. Students will watch a video about traditional dresses in Ecuador.

Activities:

- 1. Students work with a partner doing research.
- 2. Presentations.
- 3. Class discussion.

Closing: Homework: Compare and contrast different dresses from different countries. Talk about colors, accessories and the history behind the dress.
